Additionally, he has significant experience negotiating fiber optic cable and network projects on behalf of cities and counties and advises on the provision of broadband service by city and county owned ISPs. Bennett also manages right-of-way and utility disputes, handling encroachments, access rights and authority disputes, and addressing aesthetic and regulatory right-of-way implications with providers.

Bennett's practice also involves representing public and private property owners, cities, counties and water districts in cell site leasing negotiations and related disputes. A large portion of existing wireless facility agreements are often quite one-sided in the wireless tenant's favor and Bennett specializes in leveraging key provisions to benefit property owners by enhancing control and oversight of their properties, while ensuring adequate compensation.
